- ① Located on the shores of Lake Kussharo, Japan's largest caldera lake
- ② Lake Kussharo is Japan's largest freshwater lake that fully freezes over each winter
- ③ It features Japan's biggest "God's crossing" ice ridges—2 meters high, 10 km long (surpassing Lake Suwa)
- ④ As well as Japan's largest central island in a freshwater lake (12 km in circumference)
- ⑤ Nearby, Lake Mashu is Japan's clearest lake (second in the world after Lake Baikal)
- ⑥ Lake Kussharo, a natural dam, is also the source of Kushiro Marsh, Japan's largest wetland
